Delta Lambda lost long time sister Barbara Hill in December. Barbara was initiated into DKG in 1969, and would have celebrated her 50th DKG anniversary this year.

Barbara Moore Hill, born on 27 July 1919, died peacefully at her Carmel Valley Manor home on 18 December 2018. Mrs. Hill is pre-deceased by her husband Nathanael Hill, her daughter Nancy Hill Birr, and her brother and sister (Walter E. Moore, Jr., and Lucille Moore Barnhart). She is survived by her daughter, Carol Ann Hill and her nephews, James H. Barnhart and Peter D. Barnhart. Mrs. Hill was a 1940 graduate of Stanford University, received her teaching credential from U. C. Berkeley in 1960, and her Masters Degree in Education from San Francisco State University in 1965. She was an educator in the Oakland Public School district from 1960 through 1980, first as a teacher and then as an administrator (head-teacher, vice-principal and principal).
