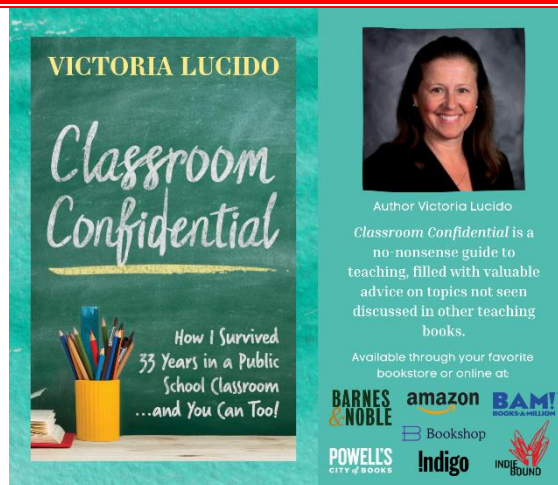
Leadership Retreat, Virtual

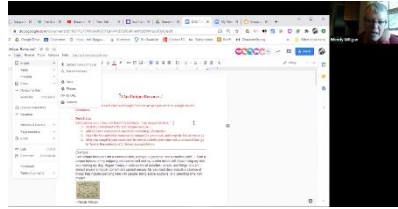

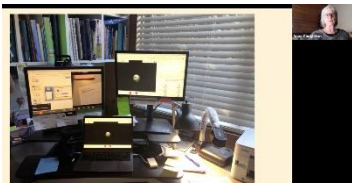
This painting, by Betty Aynaga, was submitted to the MMA miniatures exhibit, on view through December 20.

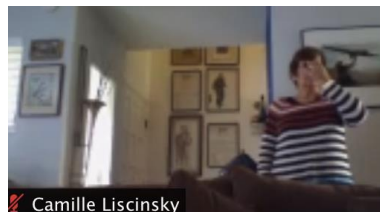
Rochelle Davis gave us a welcome Seventh Inning yoga stretch.

- I wonder what the next meeting will reveal?

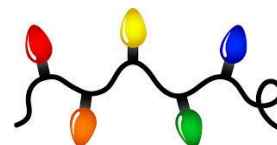




Holiday Meeting December 5, 2020 10AM

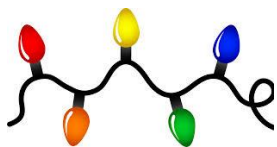
Come one, come all to our end of year ‘Zoom Party’!

You do not need to register in advance for this meeting, just follow the instructions in the red box - use computer, laptop, iPad, notebook, cell phone or rotary phone to connect.

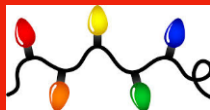
