- ~Should live or work in the general vicinity
- ~Should have proven leadership or show leadership potential
- ~Should be an involved, contributing member of professional organizations and/or her community
- ~Must be sponsored by one or more member(s) who knows her professional competence
- ~Should be the kind of person who accepts responsibility and participates willingly as she will be expected to assume leadership roles in our chapter
