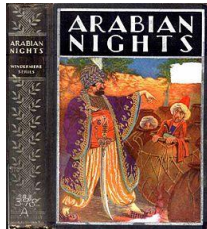
Happy New Year to you all!

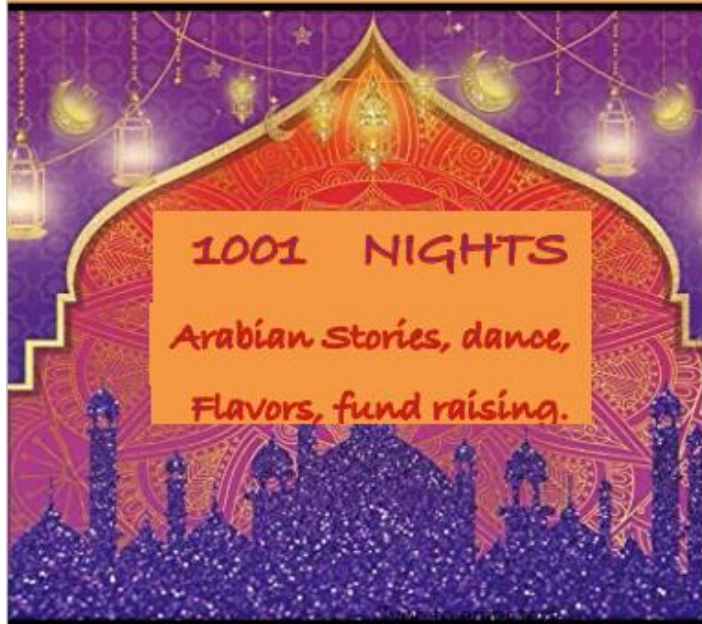
